HSLDA is a non-profit advocacy organization established to defend and advance the constitutional right of parents to direct the education of their children and to protect family freedoms. Through annual

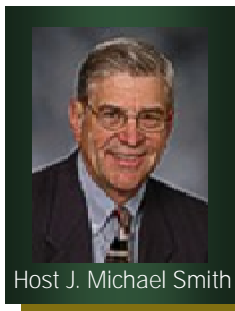
memberships, HSLDA is made up of tens of thousands of families united in service together, providing a strong voice when and where needed.

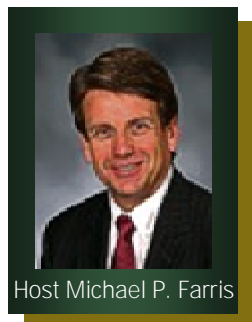

Janet Paschal

Janet Paschal is an inspirational gospel vocalist and performer, often associated with Bill Gaither's Homecoming Tour, and hailed as one of the most soulfully versatile voices in Christian Music.

A native of Reidsville, North Carolina, Paschal recalls writing as a child that one day she would be a Gospel singer. Raised in a religious and musically inclined family, Paschal's grandfather was a minister who served as a great inspiration in her life.

She has been a member of The LeFevres, a member of televangelist Jimmy Swaggart's Crusade Team, and in 1986, began her solo career, releasing her first album entitled 'I Give You Jesus' on Jimmy Swaggart's ministry label, Shiloh Records. Since then, she's released seven more successful albums, received countless awards, and numerous Dove and Grammy nominations. Paschal is consistently named one of Christian Music's top female vocalists.

In 1997, she became an accomplished author with her release of The Good Road, a collection of her own writings and reflections on life, based on her favorite book of the Bible, Jeremiah.

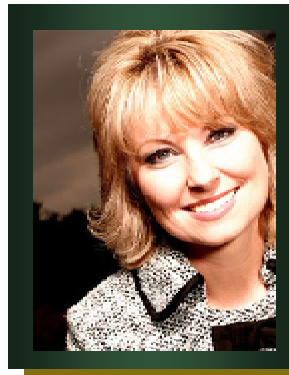
With more than 100 concerts a year, Paschal has performed at such notable venues as Carnegie Hall, The Sydney Opera House, The Grand Ole Opry,

and The Kennedy Center.

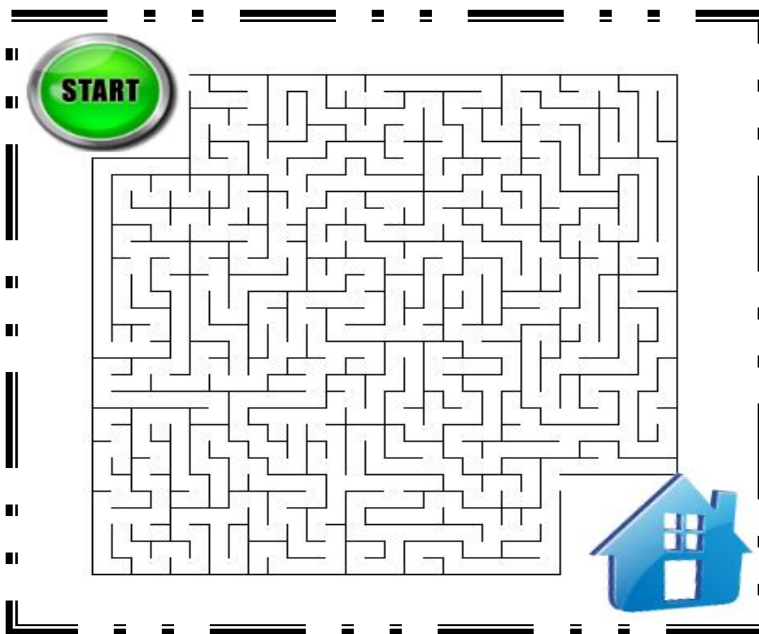
In 2005 Paschal was diagnosed with breast cancer and received 11 months of treatment. Following a clean bill of health, Paschal recorded a new project of hymns titled, Sounds Like Sunday, which benefits the Susan G. Komen Foundation for breast cancer research. She has developed her own radio program titled Walking the Good Road which discusses life with cancer.

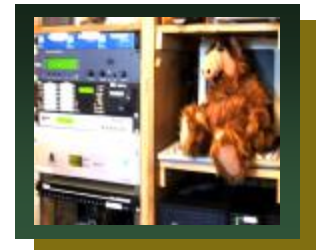

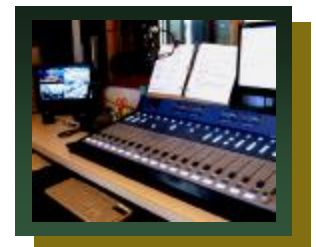
